


1983 - Free Software

Free Software

(sometimes also called *Open Source*,
Libre Software, *FOSS*, *FLOSS*...)

protective (Copyleft)

strong copyleft (e.g. GNU GPL)

weak copyleft (e.g. GNU LGPL)

non-protective (e.g. X11 license)

proprietary software

binary only

shareware

free-download software
